

There is a vacancy for an **Air Traffic Control Officer** at London Southend Airport. The airport is currently embarking on several projects to enhance the airport for its future role as a regional airport for the Essex and London Thames Gateway region.

The airport is situated in Class G airspace beneath the London TMA and handles a varied mixture of aircraft types from microlights to B757s. In 2005, Southend handled 53,000 airport movements and 14,000 overflights.

The ideal candidate will have experience in a busy G/A environment and hold current UK CAA Aerodrome Control Instrument, Approach Control Procedural and Approach Control Surveillance ratings, as well as a Meteorological Observers certificate. You will also be required to carry out airside safety inspections, and will be expected to be an integral part of the ongoing safety provision at the airport.

Applications from candidates who do not hold an Approach Control Procedural or Surveillance ratings may be considered, but suitability for future training is essential.

The successful applicant will be employed by London Southend Airport Co. Ltd, to work as a member of a small, flexible, enthusiastic team ensuring safety in a busy ATC environment. You will be required to work shifts (including weekends and nights) as the airport is open H24.
